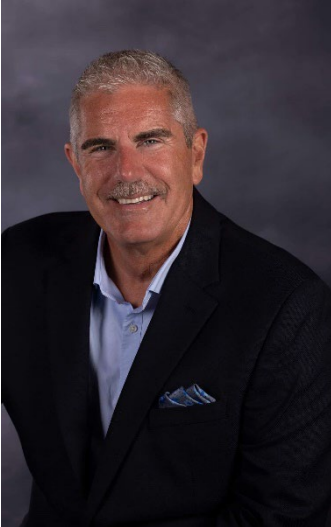


**CAMA BOARD REPRESENTATIVE FOR

John Jamieson is the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Three Rivers in eastern Prince Edward Island. John joined Three Rivers in October 2023 after working for many years in the Canadian agriculture and food system. Prior to joining Three Rivers, he served as the President and CEO of the Canadian Centre for Food Integrity (CCFI). CCFI is a national non-profit member-based organization with a clearly defined mandate to help Canada's food system earn public trust by coordinating research, resources, and dialogue with consumers.

Before joining CCFI, Mr. Jamieson worked in the Government of Prince Edward Island and simultaneously served as the Deputy Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries and the Deputy Minister of Rural and Regional Development. Through his work in government, he became acutely aware of the importance of transparency in building and earning public trust for all levels of government.

John Jamieson has considerable knowledge of industry and volunteer associations and has sat on the boards of several national, regional, and provincial organizations including Dalhousie University's Faculty of Agriculture Advisory Committee, Farm and Food Care Canada Foundation, Canadian Federation of Agriculture, and, most recently as the President of Island Trails, an organization that manages hiking and recreational trails across Prince Edward Island.

John's experience with local government includes serving for 12 years as the Chairperson of the Rural Municipality of Bonshaw, PEI. John and his wife, MJ reside in Stratford, PEI.
