




FOUR GENERAL CONCLUSIONS ABOUT OUR FUTURE:


- -The demographic and economic changes we will experience in the coming decades will not be simple extensions of past trends;

- -Ready or not, here it comes all communities, all sectors, all businesses (big & small) will have to manage a future that is much different from what we have become accustomed to.


