Prior to making the move into municipal administration, I had the privilege of working with the Romeo Dallaire Child Soldiers Initiative, as an instructor, at the United Nations Peacekeeping Deployment Training Center in Amman, Jordan. I currently serve the Rural Municipality of Lac du Bonnet as their Chief Administrative Officer.
